Here's how to join PTA using a QR code and will be able to navigate directly to the page on their phone.



Users point their camera phones to the QR code and will be able to navigate directly to the page on their phone.

Users can sign up multiple members of a household and collect optional donations with a single checkout.



For Iphone users

Step 1: Open up the camera app. Apple's iPhones have built-in QR code scanning capabilities right in the camera app itself.

Step 2: Position your phone so the QR code appears in the digital viewfinder.

For Android Users

Step 1: Check to see if your Android phone supports QR code scanning. The Google Assistant can detect QR codes, though. Simply long-press on the *Home* icon or say "OK, Google," then tap the *Google Lens* icon at the bottom right.

Step 2: Open your scanning app. Open up the app, whether it's Bixby, QR Code Reader, Samsung Optical Reader, or whatever option is installed on your Android phone.

Step 3: Position the QR code. Remember, the code's corners should be fully visible in the scanning window, and the camera should be more or less directly above the code for it to work. Hold the phone steady while it identifies the code.

Step 4: Choose the correct option. The app should then provide a pop-up option to take an action based on the QR code.
