### Jehue Middle School Presents Vear This Not That Jehue Dress Code Policy 2021-2022

 <u>No</u> clothing that is <u>revealing or low cut</u>, tank tops with <u>straps less than 2 inches</u> (not 2 fingers) wide or with large arm openings which can be revealing.



### • <u>No</u> clothing that <u>exposes undergarments</u>.



 <u>No sagging</u> pants or <u>oversized clothing</u> are permitted. Generally, 1-2 inches of "growing room" is permissible.



#### • <u>No exposed waists</u> or midriffs.



# All clothing must <u>fit appropriately</u> and be <u>worn in the manner intended</u>.



 <u>No</u> clothing with <u>holes and/or rips higher than 6</u> <u>inches</u> above the top of the knee. Wearing <u>"leggings" underneath</u> pants to hide inappropriate rips will be <u>allowed</u>.



- <u>No</u> short shorts, skirts, or dresses <u>shorter than 6 inches above the top</u> <u>of the knee</u>.
- <u>Leggings</u>/tights cannot be worn without an <u>appropriate cover</u> that <u>meet the length requirement</u>. (P.E. shorts over them is not allowed.)

## Wear This... Not That

 <u>Practical shoes</u> should be <u>worn</u> at all times. <u>Sandals</u> must have a <u>back strap</u>. <u>No steel toed boots</u> or shoes with any <u>spikes</u> or sharp objects. No <u>high</u> <u>heels or wedges</u>. (Shoe laces must be tied.)



<u>No</u> clothing/hairstyle indicative of gang affiliation. "The <u>uniform look</u> is not allowed." That is, all black, yellow, brown, purple, blue, red, etc., any writing or alteration of clothing to denote gang or crew affiliation.



- <u>No clothing or accessories</u> that depict <u>violence</u>, <u>hate or death</u>.
  No clothing that <u>promotes hostility</u> between specific groups.
- <u>No clothing which in any way is suggestive</u>, <u>vulgar</u>, or can be construed to have a <u>double meaning</u>. No 'I Boobies' <u>apparel</u>.
- <u>No clothing or accessory</u> that <u>refers to</u> any type of <u>alcohol</u>,



 <u>No sleepwear or blankets</u>. This includes slippers, pajamas, teddies, and any other item that is deemed as sleepwear.



- <u>No spike studs, tapers</u>, and/or other <u>sharp</u> objects or <u>body piercings</u>. No <u>oversized hoop</u> <u>earrings</u>. This is a safety concern, as all students participate in PE daily.
- <u>Tattoos</u> must be <u>covered</u>.



- <u>Baseball caps</u> and <u>beanies</u> must be <u>solid colored</u>, <u>without</u>
  <u>logos</u> or designs, and must be worn <u>outdoors only</u>
  (including hoods).
- <u>Hats/sunglasses</u> may only be worn in authorized areas and may not be worn inside.



# And finally, Wear This... Not That

 The <u>administration</u> will make the <u>determination if</u> the manner of <u>dress</u> or <u>grooming</u> constitutes a <u>disruption</u> to the safety of students or <u>violates school</u> <u>regulations</u> or <u>disrupts</u> the orderly operation of the school.
