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## Financial Aid

Financial Aid is any form of funding that helps pay you for college.

There are generally two ways to qualify for aid: through financial need and through merit.

- Need-based aid: The federal government calculates your financial need based on the information you provide on the FAFSA.
   Work-study dollars and most grants are need-based.
- Merit-based aid: Colleges and private organizations award scholarships to students with academic, athletic or artistic talent.





# Types of Financial Aid...



#### <u>Scholarship</u>

- An award or payment made to support a students' education, awarded on the basis of academic or other achievement.
- University Money determined by academic ability.

#### Grant

- A sum of money given by an organization, especially a government, for a particular purpose.
- State or Federal Government Money determined by financial status and academic accomplishment.

#### Work-study

- A college program that enables a student to work part-time while attending school.
- State or Federal money maximum of 10 hours a week.

# Types of Financial Aid...

#### Loan

- Money lent at an interest rate.
- Subsidized and unsubsidized loans.

What is the difference between a subsidized and unsubsidized loan?

#### **Subsidized loans**

Are based on financial need. Government pays interest while enrolled at least half-time Only accept what you need!

#### **Unsubsidized loans**

Are not based on financial need Interest accrues on loan while in school Student responsible for paying interest Only accept what you need!

## The FAFSA

The FAFSA- Free Application for Federal Student Aid

You are eligible to complete the FAFSA if you are a:

- U.S Citizen
- Permanent Resident
- Eligible Non Citizen
- T Visa holder





## The CADAA

The CADAA- California Dream Act Application

You are eligible to complete the CADAA if you are a:

- Undocumented
- Have a valid or expired DACA
- Have Temporary Protected Status (TPS)
- Meet the non resident exemptions requirements under AB 540

# For the FAFSA...

- Before starting the FAFSA the student and parent must each create their own Federal Student Aid Identification commonly referred to as a FSA ID.
- A FSA ID serves as your username and password to access the FAFSA and your electronic signature.
- You will also use it to access your FAFSA and renew it every year.



# Let's look at the different sections....


### 1. Student Demographics

- Student's Legal Name
- Address
- Birthdate
- Social Security Number
- $\circ$  High School Completion Status
- What college certificate will you be working towards
- Work study (Yes)
- If you are a male, it will ask if you would like to register for the selective services (all males are required by law to register when they turn 18).
  - i. Since it's a federal law, you won't be able to receive federal financial aid if you don't register.
  - ii. If you're not 18 yet, Federal Student Aid will wait until your 18<sup>th</sup> birthday or shortly thereafter to send your registration to Selective Service.



## The School Section

The Student will enter their HS information, up to 10 colleges they plan on applying to and where they plan to live while attending college.




## **Dependency Status**

The FAFSA will determine your dependency status by asking up to 13 questions.


Dependent students must provide parental information, along with their own.

Independent students won't include parental information but will include their spouse, if married.








### **Financial Information**

- Select if your parents already completed, will file or are not going to file their 2019 taxes.
- Then enter the type of tax return that was filed and the filing status.
- If the parent has a FSA ID select, Link to IRS and enter the FSA ID information.
- If using the IRS retrieval tool you must enter the information exactly how it appears on your taxes
- If you are unable to use the retrieval tool you will need to manually enter the information
- The student will also have to complete their financial information. Most students will select, Not going to File and will move forward with the application.





## Sign and Submit

- The student will enter their FSA ID to electronically sign the FAFSA
- The parent will then enter their FSA ID to electronically sign the FAFSA. If the parent was unable to create a FSA ID they will need to print the signature page and physically sign the document and mail it the address of the document.
- After you sign, you must select, Submit My FAFSA Now.



## **Confirmation**

- You'll receive a confirmation page, with a confirmation number, after your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form or correction is successfully submitted. Your confirmation number is proof that your FAFSA form or correction was successfully submitted. Print a copy of your confirmation page for your records. If you provided an email address on your FAFSA form or correction, the confirmation page will be automatically emailed to you.
- Students will then receive a financial aid award letter around the time they receive their acceptances. A financial aid award letter is the notification that students receive informing them how much financial aid a school is willing to offer. If a student is awarded a Cal Grant they must create a profile on the CSAC website, <a href="https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/">https://mygrantinfo.csac.ca.gov/</a>, and accept their award.

Estimated Expected Family Contribution (EFC) = 000000 The EFC is a measure of how much you can contribute to the cost of your education. Schools use your EFC to determine your federal student aid eligibility.

The EFC is <u>not</u> how much aid you will receive or how much you have to pay for college.

Based on the <u>eligibility criteria</u>, you may be eligible for the following:

Pell Grant Estimate - \$5,920.00

<u>Direct Stafford Loan</u> Estimate - \$5,500.00
You may also be eligible to receive other federal, state, or institutional grants, scholarships, and/or work-study.

In addition, you should learn about federal tax benefits for education, including the American Opportunity Tax Credit (AOTC).
