- ✓ FSA ID (Please create one before the workshop at www.fsaid.ed.gov)
- ✓ Driver's license, if you have one
- ✓ Social Security Card, if you have one
- ✓ Alien registration number, if you have one
- ✓ Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) if you have one
- ✓ List of colleges you are interested in attending
- ✓ Most current bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income such as welfare benefits, Social Security benefits, or child support payments
- ✓ Prior-prior year tax information (1040s and W2s)
