Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to school Kordyak Lion Cubs!!! We are so excited to have our amazing scholars back at school for in-person learning. As we enter into the 2021-2022 academic school year, it is truly important that we work together as one to ensure our scholars have the safest and healthiest transition possible as they return. The health and safety of all of our school community stakeholders is our number one priority.

In order to provide a safe, nurturing and engaging learning environment for our scholars, Kordyak must make certain that we have all the necessary precautions established. Therefore, listed are the following changes that have occurred for the betterment of each scholar:

- All scholars must have a mask on to enter campus and must be worn throughout the school day.
 Masks may only be removed to eat breakfast & lunch, and when playing outside during recess, lunch, and physical education.
- All adults on Kordyak's campus will be required to wear a mask at all times, including arrival and dismissal times of scholars.
- Scholars may arrive to Kordyak at 7:15 am. Please do not leave any scholar unattended until temperature has been taken. In addition, students may not be dropped off prior to 7:20 am.
- Scholars should be picked up immediately after dismissal by parent/guardian or caregiver.
- Breakfast and lunch will be served to all of our scholars. We will be reducing the number of scholars eating inside of the cafeteria when the weather permits.
- Until further notice, parent volunteers will not be allowed on-campus. However, we would like to encourage parents to complete the Parent Volunteer Application.
- PLEASE make sure Kordyak has all of your updated phone numbers. California's Education Code requires that all parents/guardians provide schools with updated and working phone numbers.
- Scholars are strongly encouraged to bring a refillable water bottle to school. Kordyak has refillable water dispensing stations for our scholars.
- If your scholar has their Chromebook or hard cover textbooks from the 2020-2021 academic school year, please return them to Kordyak ASAP.

Throughout the school year, Kordyak will go over and beyond to ensure that we effectively communicate with all of our school community stakeholders. We will communicate through Blackboard Phone Messages, Remind App, school website, and personal phone calls.
