LICENSING & INTERNSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

- · Be 18 years of age or older
- Possess a valid California ID or California Driver's License
- Pass a Criminal Background Check (this includes DUI's)
- Drug screening may be required

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

The following documents must be submitted along with a completed application at the time of registration.

- · High School Diploma
- · Letter of intent for admission
- 2 <u>professional</u> letters of recommendation*

*All letters of recommendation MUST be SIGNED and DATED within the last three years. (Typed signatures will NOT be accepted)
