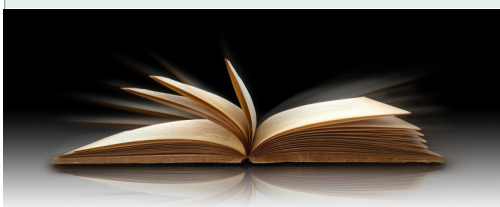

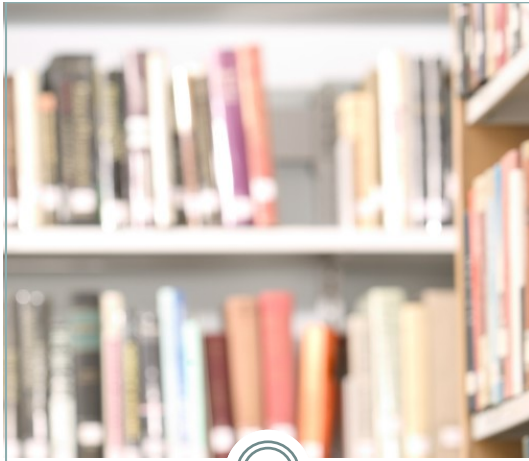
Library hours:

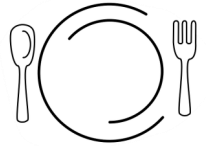
