# RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION RIALTO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

#### JUNETEENTH INDEPENDENCE DAY HOLIDAY

**WHEREAS**, on June 19, 1865, Union soldiers, led by Major General Gordon Granger, arrived in Galveston, Texas, with news that the Civil War had ended and that the enslaved were free; and;

**WHEREAS**, African-Americans who had been slaves in the Southwest celebrated June 19, commonly known as "Juneteenth Independence Day", as inspiration and encouragement for future generations; and;

**WHEREAS**, African-Americans from the Southwest have continued the tradition of observing Juneteenth Independence Day for over 150 years; and;

**WHEREAS**, on June 17, 2021, President Biden proclaimed June 19, as Juneteenth Day of Observance and called upon the people of the United States to acknowledge and celebrate the end of the Civil War and the emancipation of Black Americans, and commit together to eradicate systemic racism that still undermines our founding ideals and collective prosperity; and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board recognizes Juneteenth, June 19, as:

- 1. An opportunity to recognize the impact, achievements, and contributions from Black staff, teachers, administrators, and students to the Rialto community at large; and
- 2. A day to honor and reflect on the significant role that African Americans have played in the history of the United States and how they have enriched society through their steadfast commitment to promoting unity and equality; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Rialto Unified School District will designate June 19, 2022, and June 19 of each year thereafter, as a local holiday in honor of Juneteenth, until such time as it is designated a state mandated holiday by the Governor and/or State Legislature.
