Job Description

DEFINITION

Under the direction of a Child Development Department Administrator, the Child Development TOSA will provide: (1) teacher support in curriculum and instruction development and implementation, (2) staff development for teachers, instructional assistants and apprentices, (3) parent education.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Deliver in-classroom support to teachers of young children.
- Develop and provide professional growth training for Child Development Employees.
- Develop and provide parent education workshops.
- Oversee the Preschool Parent Advisory Committee.
- Supervise, evaluate, and monitor professional growth plans for instructional assistants and apprentices.
- Schedule RHCC instructional assistant and apprentice weekly work assignments.
- Support the implementation of Title 5, Title 22, ITERS, ECERS, Desired Results, NAEYC Accreditation, and CSTP Standards.
- Other duties as assigned but not to include certificated employee evaluation.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Current child growth and development research.

- Demonstrate nurturing demeanor

Experience and Education:

- Possession of a valid Bachelor's degree in child/human development from an accredited college or university
- Possession of a current CTC Child Development Teacher Permit
- Completion of three (3) units of approved Child Development Infant/Toddler coursework
- Successful experience teaching in a licensed early childhood program
- Experience with early literacy (birth to 8) development
- Experience in working effectively with adults
- Proven mastery of developmentally appropriate practices
- Possession of a valid California driver's license and a private vehicle
- Maintain current pediatric CPR and First Aid certifications
- Possession of a Preventative health measures certificate

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Physical class:

Moderate – Must be able to lift 30 pounds. Will need to be able to lift infants, toddlers, and young children.

Work area requirements:

Office area, regular classroom, on the playground, parking lot, bus stop areas and possibility field trips. Ability to use common school hand tools, computer, telephone, fax, photocopy equipment, email, word processing, graphing, presentation and data base software. Ability to transverse any part of a 10-50 acre campus which would include asphalt, sidewalks, grass on playgrounds, dirt, and/or bus areas.

Physical requirements:

Occasionally/low - up to 3 hours

Frequently/Medium - 3 to 6 hours

Constantly/High - 6 to 8 hours

Stooping: Occasionally

Bending: Occasionally

Crouching: Occasionally

Grasping: Frequently

Fingering: Occasionally

Push/Pull: Occasionally

Carrying: Frequently

Standing: 0-30 minutes to 1 hour

Kneeling: Not required

Sitting: 0 or may sit 60 minutes a day

*Driving: Must have ability to get to inservices meeting

Walking: Frequently - up to 4 ½ hours a day

****Possession of a current California Driver's license, a DMV printout and the ability to be covered by the company auto insurance is required.***

Frequent motion:

Twisting: Not required

Wrist flexion: Yes – Occasionally

Forward shoulder/neck flexion: Yes – Occasionally

Reaching to above shoulder level: Yes -Occasionally to put up classroom decorations

Elbow flexion/extension: Yes - Frequently

Reaching to shoulder level: Yes - Occasionally

Reaching below shoulder level: Yes - Frequently

Sensory requirements:

Ability to see: Constantly

Ability to hear: Constantly

Ability to talk: Constantly

Ability to smell: Constantly

Ability to touch: Constantly
