#### SWIMMING POOL MAINTENANCE WORKER/CUSTODIAN

#### **DEFINITION**

Under general supervision, to operate, clean, repair and maintain the swimming pool and related equipment; to perform routine custodial and maintenance task, and to do other related duties as assigned and/or required.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES**

- Perform a variety of duties and activities related to preventive maintenance and repair of swimming pool equipment and the cleaning of a swimming pool.
- Operate pool filters and pumps.
- Test pool water for chemical content and balance and apply proper chemicals as needed.
- Clean swimming pool water purification systems.
- Perform routine repairs and adjustments to pumps, chlorination equipment utilized with a large commercial type swimming pool.
- Identify and report needed repairs and maintenance problems.
- Brush, skim, and vacuum pool surface, wash down deck and scrub swimming pool tile surfaces.
- Replace empty chlorine tanks.
- Clean pool deck and adjacent areas.
- Clean and maintain office and locker room areas.
- Requisition, receive, store and maintain and adequate inventory of swimming pool supplies and materials.
- Maintain records pertaining to a swimming pool.
- Review and monitor the swimming pool maintenance activities to ensure compliance with State and County regulations.
- Store, maintain, and set up as necessary aquatic athletic equipment.
- Perform a variety of other custodial, grounds maintenance, and general maintenance functions as assigned.
- May be assigned to custodial duties as a part of the school's custodial staff.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

<u>Knowledge of:</u> Methods, techniques, supplies, materials and equipment; utilized in the cleaning, care and maintenance of a large commercial type swimming pool.

Methods, techniques, and procedures used in maintaining and performing routine repairs to swimming pool related equipment.

Basic custodial cleaning methods.

Safe working methods and procedures.

**Ability to:** Sanitize, clean and maintain a commercial type swimming pool.

Prepare and maintain needed records and reports.

Make simple arithmetic calculations.

Adjust work schedules to accommodate school aquatic activities.

Develop and maintain cooperative working relationships.

### **PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

The physical requirements indicated below are examples of the physical aspects that this position classification must perform in carrying out essential job functions.

- will infrequently exert 50 to 75 pounds of force to lift, carry, push, pull or otherwise move objects
- will walk or stand for extended periods while sitting some of the time, will regularly ascend and descend ladders, stairs, scaffolding and ramps
- must possess the ability to hear and perceive the nature of sound
- must possess visual acuity and depth perception
- must be capable of providing oral information, both in person and over the telephone/other communication devices
- must possess the manual dexterity to operate hand tools and to handle and work with various materials and objects
- may be occasionally exposed to hot, cold, wet, humid, or windy conditions caused by weather
- potential exposure to hazardous and toxic chemicals and fumes is one aspect of this position.

Reasonable accommodation may be made to enable a person with a disability to perform the essential functions of the job.

## **EXPERIENCE AND EDUCATION**

Any combination of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and skills is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the required knowledge and skills would be:

**Experience**: Two years of experience in the maintenance and operation of a commercial type swimming pool and related equipment.

<u>Education</u>: Verification of a High School diploma, a GED certificate, or a higher degree; supplemented by training or course work in the operation and maintenance of a commercial type swimming pool.

# **Certificate Requirement**

Commercial swimming pool maintenance certificate issued by the County, or its equivalent. A standard Red Cross First Aid Certificated, which includes CPR training.

<u>Condition of Employment</u>: Insurability by the District's liability insurance carrier may be required.

<u>License Requirement</u>: Verification of a valid California Department of Motor Vehicle Operator's License is required.
