Role of Each ELAC Officer

President:

- Conduct ELAC meetings

Vice President:

- Assists the chairperson in conducting ELAC meetings
- Conducts ELAC meetings in the absence of the president

Secretary:

- Takes minutes of meetings
- Submits minutes to the principal or designee

DELAC Representative:

- Attends DELAC meetings
- Serve as liaison between ELAC & DELAC, takes monthly report of ELAC meeting to DELAC and brings information back to the school form the DELAC meeting.



ELAC Members' Duties

1. Follow your school's ELAC bylaws when conducting meetings and carrying out other responsibilities.
2. Advise the School Site Council on the development of the Single Plan for Student Achievement and monies spent for the support of English Learners.
3. Elect a representative to the District English Learner Advisory Committee (DELAC). (DELAC representative and alternate must be the parent of an English Learner at the current site).
4. Send and receive information to/from DELAC.
5. Send and receive information to/from School Site Council (SSC).
6. Participate in training provided by the school and the district.

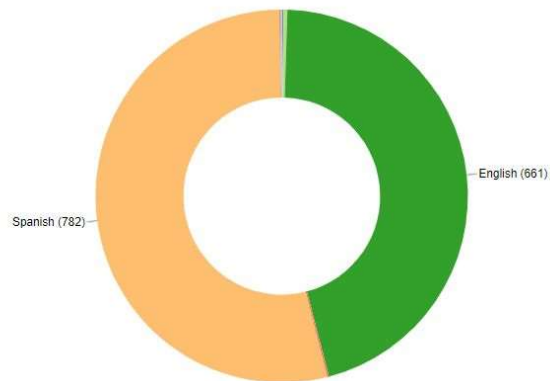
