Below, you will find our Bridge Academy schedule. **Attendance and participation is required, as your child will be graded!** Throughout the school day, especially during Independent Online Work time, I will be ready to assist. The SKIES program allows me to be online and assist in near real-time, as I will be able to see your child's work when they've completed and posted it. I can also post updates and resources to the assignment in near real-time if students are struggling with a particular assignment. Please keep in mind that I have to monitor 24 students online, all with different needs. If you need assistance during assignments, I will help your child as soon as I am able to do so. **When done with assignments, mark the assignment as "Turned In" in Google Classroom!**

Please remember that it is important to take short "brain breaks" between assignments, especially with education happening mainly through a computer screen. I believe that 2-3 minutes here and there will help, but please ensure that your child has enough time to complete the assignments. Also, make sure to **keep the Chromebook charged!**
