Minutes from 09/02/20

Site Report

- 1. The Parent Compact was reviewed and members made suggestions to revise it. Suggestions to include the following items were made:
 - a. School will provide SEL services and tutoring for students.
 - b. Parents will provide updated contact information promptly to the school whenever it changes.
 - c. Parents will monitor that students are attending SEL and tutoring being offered by the school.
 - d. Students will attend SEL and tutoring sessions that are offered by the school.i. Sylvia Vargas motioned. Angeles Rodas second. Motion carried.
- 2. School Plan goals were reviewed and the following suggestions were made. Mrs. Garcia asked parents what type of training they wanted. Mr. Urteaga asked what other types of things they would want for their students other than academics.
 - a. Goal 1: Include technology purchases to provide access to the core curriculum, especially during Bridge Academy online learning. (i.e., ViewSonic screens, hot spots, smart pens, writing pads, One Note, etc.) Sylvia Vargas discussed the need to keep the students engaged, especially while participating in the Bridge Academy.
 - b. Goal 2: PD opportunities for teachers that include: GATE certification for teachers, technology training, and how to teach online.
 - c. Goal 3: Parent Involvement opportunities: Bullying workshop online, etc.i. Sue Chan motioned. Sylvia Vargas second. Motion to approve carried.
- 3. i-Ready 1st diagnostic results were discussed in both Reading and Math. Currently 50% of students are scoring at-risk in Math and 54% of students are scoring at-risk in Reading. These are baseline scores after students are returning from an extended time off from instruction due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The school is addressing these learning losses through after-school interventions with the ELA and Math coaches, as well as tutoring with teachers during Student Support hours after school.
