In consideration for permitting Participant to participate as a volunteer in the Event as directed by the relevant staff, the undersigned, for themselves, and for their respective heirs, personal representatives and assigns, agree as follows:

Assumption of Risk: The undersigned and/or digital signee hereby acknowledges and agree that they understand the nature of the of the Event; that Participant is qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate therein; that there are certain inherent risks and dangers associated with the Event; and that, except as expressly set forth herein, they, knowingly and voluntarily, accept, and assume responsibility for, each of these risks and dangers, and all other risks and dangers, that could arise out of, or occur during, Participant's participation in the Event.

Release and Waiver: The undersigned hereby **RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE:**

Rialto Unified School District nor Carter High School, or any subdivision thereof, and each of them, their officers and employees, (collectively, the "Releases"), from and for any liability resulting from any personal injury, accident or illness (including death), and/or property loss, however caused, arising from, or in any way related to, Participant's participation in the Event, except for those cause by the willful misconduct, gross negligence or intentional torts of the above parities, as applicable.

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: The undersigned and/or digital signee also hereby agree to INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD the Release HARMLESS from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities including, but not limited to, attorney's fees, arising from, or in any way related to, Participant's participation in the Event, except for those arising out of the willful misconduct, gross negligence or intentional torts of the above parities, as applicable.

Permission to Use Likeness/Name: The undersigned and/or digital signee further agree to allow, without compensation, Participant's likeness and/or name to appear, and to otherwise be used, in material, regardless of media form, promoting **Carter High School or Rialto Unified School District** and/or in its championships, events and activities, including those of its representatives and licensees.

Severability: The undersigned and/or digital signee expressly agree that the foregoing assumption of risk, release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the state of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full force, and effect.

Acknowledgement of Understanding: The undersigned and/or digital signee have read this assumption of risk, release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement, and have had the opportunity to ask questions about the same. The undersigned and/or digital signee fully understand the assumption of risk, release and waiver of liability and indemnity agreement, that the undersigned and/or digital signee are giving up substantial rights in connection therewith, and that its terms are contractual, and not mere recital. Code of Ethics – Athletes

DO NOT SEND TO CIF SOUTHERN SECTION

A copy of this form must be kept on file in the athletic director's office at the local high school.

Athletics is an integral part of the school's total educational program. All school activities, curricular and extra-curricular, in the classroom and on the playing field, must be congruent with the school's stated goals and objectives established for the intellectual, physical, social and moral development of its students. It is within this context that the following Code of Ethics is presented.

As an athlete, I understand that it is my responsibility to:

1. Place academic achievement as the highest priority.
2. Show respect for teammates, opponents, officials and coaches.
3. Respect the integrity and judgment of game officials.
4. Exhibit fair play, sportsmanship and proper conduct on and off the playing field.
5. Maintain a high level of safety awareness.
6. Refrain from the use of profanity, vulgarity and other offensive language and gestures.
7. Adhere to the established rules and standards of the game to be played.
8. Respect all equipment and use it safely and appropriately.
9. Refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, illegal and non-prescriptive drugs, anabolic steroids or any substance to increase physical development or performance that is not approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, Surgeon General of the United States or American Medical Association.
10. Know and follow all state, section and school athletic rules and regulations as they pertain to eligibility and sports participation.
11. Win with character, lose with dignity.

As a condition of membership in the CIF, all schools shall adopt policies prohibiting the use and abuse of androgenic/anabolic steroids. All member schools shall have participating students and their parents, legal guardian/caregiver agree that the athlete will not use steroids without the written prescription of a fully licensed physician (as recognized by the AMA) to treat a medical condition (Article 503.I).

By signing below, both the participating student athlete and the parents, legal guardian/caregiver hereby agree that the student shall not use androgenic/anabolic steroids without the written prescription of a fully licensed physician (as recognized by the AMA) to treat a medical condition. We recognize that under CIF Bylaw 202, there could be penalties for false or fraudulent information. We also understand that the _____ (school/school district name) policy regarding the use of illegal drugs will be enforced for any violations of these rules.
