Notice to all Diploma Students:

All courses are Independent study, students are required to participate consistently on a weekly basis via Edgenuity. Students are also required to check-in with their teacher regularly during their scheduled office hours via email or the Edgenuity Chat Messenger.

Virtual attendance/participation on Edgenuity is vital to your success in the program. Your teacher may require in-person check-ins on an individual basis.

You are herby notified that you can be dropped at any time by the teacher or by the office due to poor attendance and/or minimal participation.

Ex: If a student falls into the "behind" (Red) status, they are at risk for being dropped.

Independent Study Policy:

By enrolling in an independent study course, you agree to the following:

- Complete at least 5-7 hours of work per week and maintain an on-track (blue) status on Edgenuity.
 - Students should be completing a minimum of 2 credits per week to maintain on track.
- Pre-tests and End-of-Unit Tests must be unblocked by your teacher during the
 office hours you selected, unless otherwise notified by your teacher.
- You have 24/7 access to your Edgenuity account, with the exception of testing which is only available during your scheduled office hours.
- You are encouraged to complete as much work as possible.
