



## Hybrid VS Bridge Academy

**Hybrid-** Hybrid Learning provides in-person instructional time and learning opportunities for students at school and within their homes allowing the District to comply with social distancing requirements. This will give students an opportunity to seamlessly pivot between a Hybrid Model or a complete virtual Bridge Academy Model, if necessary. Students will be enrolled in two groups. Both groups of students will attend school at the site, in person, Tuesday - Friday. One group will physically report to the school from 7:50 am - 10:55 am. The other group will physically report to school from 11:55 am - 2:55 pm. Students will not physically attend school on Monday but will participate in 60 minutes of virtual class meetings.
