**GENERAL INFORMATION**

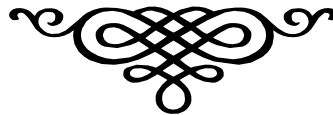
District transportation is **NOT** provided during summer school.

Students may enroll in one or two classes depending on their specific needs. Students may enroll in both 1<sup>ST</sup> semester and 2<sup>ND</sup> semester.

Breakfast will **NOT** be provided.  
Lunches will be provided for all students.

All summer school courses are offered contingent upon authorization and funding by the California State Department of Education. The Rialto Unified School District reserves the right to cancel any or all course offerings.

District dress code and school site rules apply for all students attending summer school classes. Unacceptable behavior may result in removal from summer school classes.



**ACADEMIC CLASSES – GRADES 10 -12**

If students are absent on the first day of class, or absent from class a total of 1 ½ **days**, they will be dropped from the class. **Three (3) tardies = one absence.** Students are cautioned not to enroll for only one semester of a year-long course, except for remediation or make-up. The last day to drop a class and not receive a grade for 1<sup>st</sup> Semester will be June 11, 2021. The last day to drop a class and not receive a grade for 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester will be June 24, 2021. Students who do not complete the academic summer school may forfeit future summer school enrollment opportunities.



**Please return completed registration form to your counselor ASAP as students will be enrolled on a first come, first served basis but in the following priority: current seniors who need courses for graduation prior to August 2021, then incoming seniors who are credit deficient, then incoming juniors, etc.**

Dear Parent/Guardian:

**This year summer school is highly recommended for students who:**

- Are seniors who need fifteen (15) semester credits, or fewer, in order to earn a diploma prior to September
- Are credit deficient for graduation
- Have failed classes and are in need of remediation

If your student does not meet the above criteria, the student may petition to attend summer school:

- Students who petition for inclusion based on need to facilitate graduating with their class as identified in the student's four year plan will be enrolled on a space available basis.
- Students needing a class for a special program should consult with their counselor.
- CTE classes will NOT be offered in the summer.
