By taking the Preliminary SAT®/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®) as a junior, students may meet requirements to enter the National Merit® Scholarship Program, an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.

Additionally, the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, and PSAT™ 10 connect students to another \$300 million in college scholarships for students across all major demographics. The awards—ranging from \$2,000 to full-tuition scholarships—are made possible through our partnerships with these 26 leading scholarship providers:

When students take the PSAT/NMSQT or the PSAT 10 and say “Yes” to Student Search Service®, College Board connects them with our partner organizations, which could mean money for college.

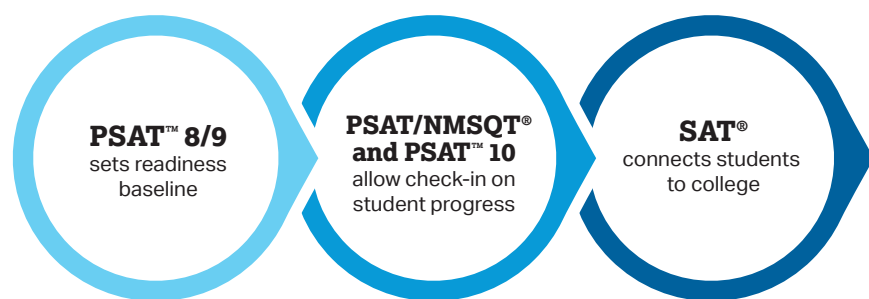
## Additional Scholarship Opportunities
