SECONDARY SCHOOLS SUPPORT IN GRADES 6-12TH

Online tutoring support is open to all students' grade levels 6-12th grades. The tutoring service is being offered at every Middle and High School within Rialto USD. Tutoring support is offered by all secondary teachers, in all subjects, Tuesday – Friday from 1:10 -2:30pm.

Additional support is provided during teacher offices hours held every Monday from 1:25 – 3:05pm.

To receive tutoring support students log onto the tutoring support link provided by their individual teacher. If you would like more information, please contact your child's teacher or school site principal.

Note: Some site have tutoring open at student request and some site have designated support bases on academic needs.

ADDITIONAL TUTORING THINK TOGETHER

In collaboration with the THINK Together Program, continues to promote student success through academic supports and enrichment activities that are aligned with what students are learning during the academic school day. Each program is designed in collaboration with the school principal to identify students who would benefit from the services, with priority given to the school's foster and homeless youth.
