County ● State of CA ● San Bernardino



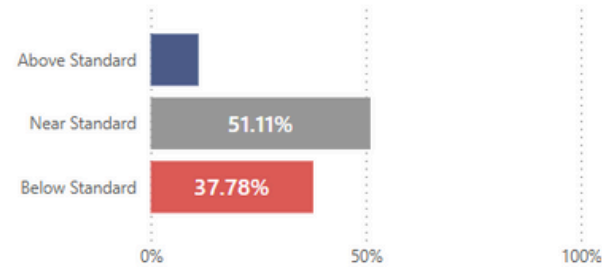
