- A personal Mentor who will guide you through the Induction process and provide you with mentoring support.
- Opportunities to participate in professional learning experiences.

Through Induction you will acquire the skills that support:

- Continual professional growth through the lens of the California Standards for the Teaching Profession (CSTP).
- Developing the habits of mind to facilitate continual improvement through the Instructional Cycle (Plan-Teach-Reflect-Apply) throughout your career.
- Earning a California Professional Clear, Multiple Subject, Single Subject and/or Education Specialist Credential, pending completion of program requirements and criteria.

Your responsibilities as a participant are to:

- Fully participate in all mentoring meetings and collaborations with your Mentor as scheduled.
- Fulfill your obligations for professional growth.
- Collaborate with your Mentor in the development and implementation of your Individual Learning Plan (ILP).
- Commit weekly time and resources towards documenting your growth and progress within your Individual Learning Plan (ILP).
- Seek assistance when needed.
- Maintain professionalism at all times, as explained in CSTP area 6.
- Collaborate with peers.
- Communicate with your Mentor and the Induction Program Specialist regarding any and all parts of the Rialto Induction Program with which you may need additional support or a change in Mentor.

I understand that the Rialto USD Induction Program is a confidential process and is not used in the teacher evaluation process. Failure to meet any/all of the above-stated responsibilities may result in withdrawal from the Rialto Unified School District Induction Program. At such time, the candidate will be notified and provided a Portability Document indicating program requirements met to date. It may also be necessary to extend the time in Induction when growth criteria is not met.
