Assembly Bill (AB) 361, until January 1, 2024, authorizes a local agency to use teleconferencing without complying with the teleconferencing requirements imposed by the Ralph M. Brown Act when a legislative body of a local agency holds a meeting during a declared state of emergency, as that term is defined, when state or local health officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, during a proclaimed state of emergency held for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, and during a proclaimed state of emergency when the legislative body has determined that meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees, as provided. Such action is valid for 30 days and may be renewed at regular or special meetings as necessary.

NOTICE: On March 16, 2022, the San Bernardino County Committee on School District Organization approved conducting regular and special meetings under the provisions of AB 361. The special meeting at 7:00 p.m. on April 13, 2022, will be held as a virtual meeting with public participation by phone.
